




**WAYS TO MAKE OUR PLANET HAPPIER!**

The planet is our home and we need to take care of it. There is pollution in the air and water, and there is trash on the land. Pollution is dangerous for humans and animals, but it is caused by humans. We need to save our environment. Here are some do's and don'ts to make our planet happier.

**DO'S**

Plant a tree. Trees produce oxygen and clean the air. Remember that our planet is for all organisms, not only for human beings.

Save energy at home. **Turn off** the TV and lights when you don't use them.



Reuse as much as you can. For example, if you go shopping, take a bag with you. Do not buy plastic bags all the time.

**DON'TS**

Don't leave water running when you wash your hands or brush your teeth. **Don't waste** water.
